# Norms of Indignation

## European Perspectives

The workshop “Norms of Indignation – European Perspectives” takes place in the context of the research project „Normative Dimensions of Indignation“. The research project considers the political dimensions of indignation as a reaction to an experienced violation of norms. We focus on the analysis of the conceptual and normative structure of expressions of indignation. Through such explication they become accessible for valuation and critique. Embedded in the normative structure’s analysis the project explicates indignation’s capability of social transformation, but also its limitations. We take into consideration European protest movements, European reappraisal processes, social transformations, and other reactions to experienced wrongs and illustrate the transformational potential as well as the limitations of indignation with European and non-European case studies.
